What is Majors in Minutes?

Majors in Minutes is an annual opportunity to help you explore UNI majors. This event uses a speed-dating style approach to connect you with senior students in each UNI major.

How does Majors in Minutes work?

Senior students from each major host a breakout room in Zoom. Every 15 minutes, you can enter a Major breakout room. This time is for you to ask questions to get a student perspective on majors that you are considering. When the 15 minute rotation ends, you can choose to enter a different Major breakout room (*or stay in the same room if you want to continue your conversation!*). You can choose to attend one rotation or all eight—it's up to you!

This event is also a great opportunity to explore double majors, minors, or certificates!

- What are you planning to do with your major when you graduate?
- Is graduate school required for this major?
