PUBLIC HEALTH

Public Health professionals seek to improve the health of the general public through education, behavior change, and improvement of the environment. Coursework includes public health theory, anatomy, human diseases, environmental health science, epidemiology, and how to address risky lifestyle behaviors.

TESOL

Students will learn the techniques, theory, and practice of helping non-native English speakers improve their English abilities.

SPANISH

Students will learn through conversation, grammar, and composition the language in-depth. There is also some area of cultural study, which generally explores the history, customs, beliefs, and artistic achievements of Spanish-speaking cultures.

RELIGION

Students will understand the role religion plays in conflicts and social change and the resources it may bring to their resolution. Students will ask fundamental questions about human existence.

ANTHROPOLOGY

Students will study the scientific and humanistic study of man's present and past biological, linguistic, social, and cultural variations. Anthropology is the study of humanity from a comprehensive, holistic approach; anthropology is the study of humankind from the earliest times to the present.

SOCIOLOGY

The sociology major covers a wide range of interests. This can include race and ethnicity to statistical analysis. Students will learn to view the world through a sociological eye.

SOCIAL WORK

Students will develop the skills and knowledge to work with a diverse population. Graduates of the social work program find jobs in child and adolescent social work, community assistance, family practice, medical social work, and working with the aged.
